

determined order followed by a sweep boat. The buddy system can also be applied especially with the under ten crowd. Regular eddy huddles are a great way to reinforce group dynamics and monitor enthusiasm.

Another important safety consideration is being in tune to the kids. "Just because we are warm does not mean our kids are", says Bob Washer of Sirius Wilderness Medicine. "A child's capacity to produce heat and to regulate body temperature is less developed than an adult. As a result, kids tend not to show signs of hypothermia as quickly as adults do". Keeping a close eye on the mood of the youngsters will also affect the flow of the day. "I often find children need to take longer lunch breaks and finish earlier in the day than older participants," says Ryan Moore of Human Heights. "As an instructor, you have to keep a finger on the pulse at all times and adjust your plan accordingly." Most kids begin to show signs of frustration and their enthusiasm begins to wane when they tire. "Accidents happen when people get tired and frustrated", adds Washer, "especially with kids".

With all of this in mind, your child's paddling skills, problem solving abilities and confidence are honed, they will become more independent. As their confidence develops, let them make their own decisions, but it ought to be a gradual process. Choosing their own line or paddling lead or sweep on some outings are great first steps. Keep in mind, you should always retain the right to veto their choices; in the end, the more experienced paddler is ultimately responsible for their safety.
