summer. A little good news though?

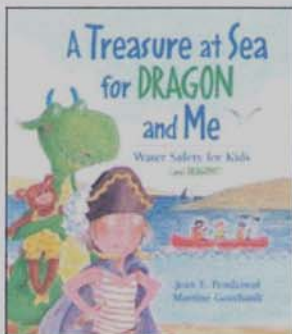
We've hunted down some innovative
